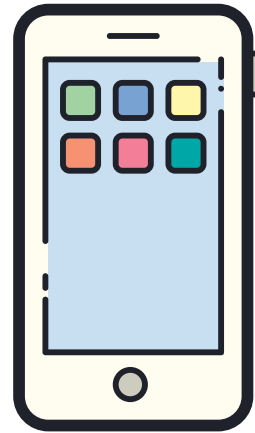


Your Mobile Phone

Technology continues to evolve; as a result, we must adapt and learn how to evolve with it

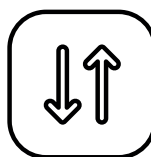
a telephone is indispensable in everyday life. you always have this with you! it makes you accessible to your environment

There you go: you are going to turn on your phone! Place your SIM card in the phone. Most smartphones come with a handy skewer that allows you to open the slide for your SIM card. Turn on your iPhone or Android phone, and go through the boot menu. That works slightly differently with an Android phone and an iPhone, so we've put the steps together for both phones.

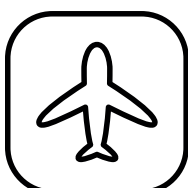

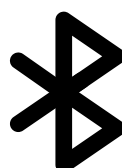

Install your new Android phone in 14 steps

- 1 Set the language you want to use on your smartphone and press 'Start'.
- 2 Connect to your Wi-Fi network and press 'Next'.
- 3 You now land in the menu of the general terms and conditions. You can only continue once you agree to the terms and conditions and the privacy policy. In addition, you can also agree to the transmission of diagnostic data and marketing information. But you don't have to.
- 4 Tick the 'End User License Agreement' and 'Privacy Policy' and press 'Next'.
- 5 Was your previous phone an Android phone too? Then you can now copy your accounts, apps and data from this phone to your new Android phone by inserting or creating your Google account email address.
- 6 Then press 'Next'.
- 7 Enter your password and press 'Next'.
Then press 'Accept'.
- 8 Tick your preferences and press 'Next'.
- 9 Now check whether the date and time on your phone is correct and adjust it if necessary.
- 10 You are now done setting up your Google account. Do you use other email addresses besides your Gmail address? Then you can also have those e-mails arrive on your smartphone.

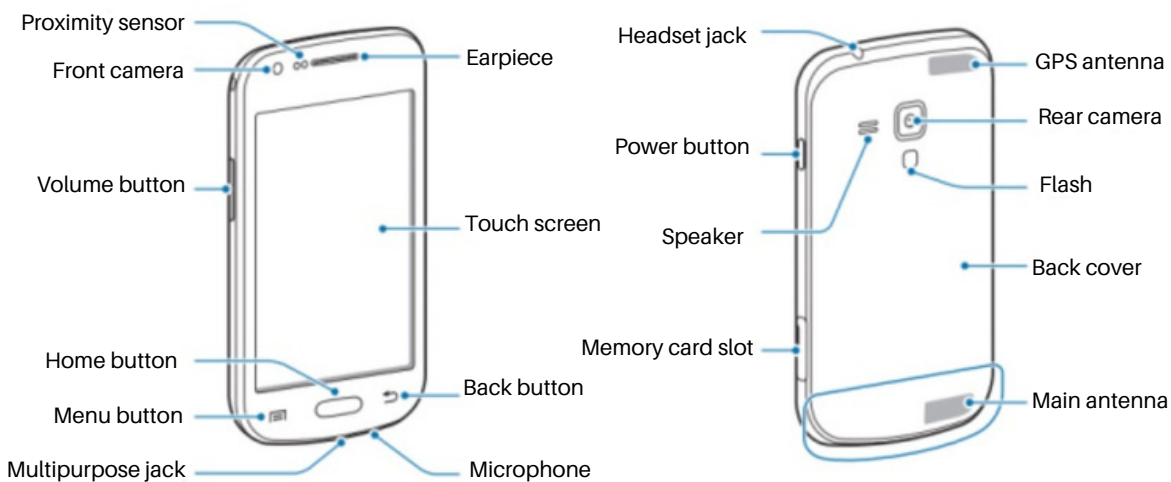
11 Now select the way you want to unlock your smartphone. This is often possible in any case by means of a PIN code, password and swipe pattern and sometimes also with a fingerprint or by means of facial recognition.

12 Now determine whether you can see incoming notifications, such as WhatsApp messages and push messages from news sites, on the lock screen of your phone.

13 If you have a Samsung phone, you can now create a Samsung account, but this is not necessary. This is necessary to use certain Samsung apps and to download apps from the Galaxy App Store.

14. Press 'Finish'. You have now set up your new Android smartphone!

Diagram of an Android phone

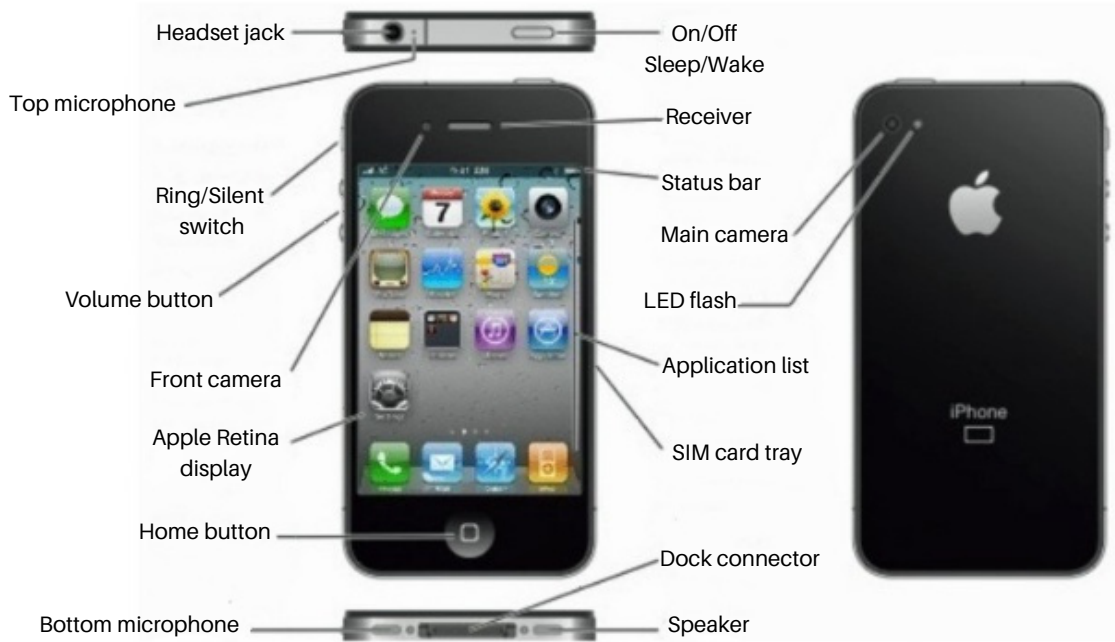




Install your new iPhone in 10 steps

- 1 Set the language you want to use on your smartphone.
- 2 Choose the country where you live.
- 3 Connect to your WiFi network.
- 4 Tap on 'Turn On Location Services' or 'Turn Off Location Services' to continue. With this, you give permission that your location can be determined more accurately via Google for WiFi and Bluetooth than is possible with GPS. This way you can easily and quickly share your location with friends via WhatsApp, use Google Maps, etc.
- 5 You can now set up the fingerprint sensor or Face ID, but you don't have to.
- 6 Press 'Continue' to set up the fingerprint or Face ID or 'Configure Touch ID later' or 'Configure Face ID later' if you don't want to do that now.
- 7 Create a six-digit security code to unlock the phone.
- 8 Tap on 'Configure as new iPhone' if you don't want data from your previous phone on your new iPhone.
- 9 Make your choice and log in with your Apple ID. If you don't have one yet, you can create one now.
- 10 You can now set up Siri, your iPhone's voice assistant, but you don't have to.
Press 'Get Started'. Your new iPhone is installed!

Working with Your Keyboard

To make the keyboard appear on screen you need to tap where you would like to type and it will appear automatically.



Tap this key for numbers and symbols

Turn on your new device. Tap Start. Connect to a Wi-Fi network when prompted.

- 1. Tap Network & Internet. Internet.**
- 2. At the bottom of the list, tap Add network.**
- 3. You may need to provide the network name (SSID) and security information.**
- 4. Tap Save.**



Call and Text

Texting has become a common way of communicating. Technically, it's called SMS (short message service). When you add multimedia, like photos or audio, it's called MMS (multimedia messaging service). It's not very difficult to do. It can be a lot faster to text someone than to pick up the phone and call them.



Finding the Text Messaging Function

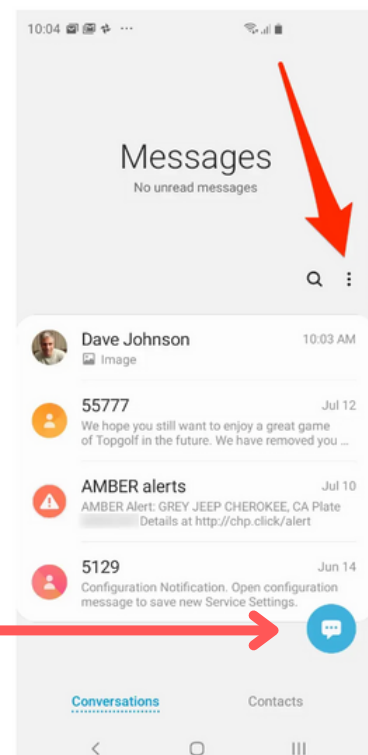
Go to your phone's home or menu page. Find the text messaging function in the menu. Usually you are looking for the icon that says "messages" or "messaging" on the main menu of the phone.

- On some phones, it will say messages on the bottom of the screen. Choose it. Select "new text message."
- With an iPhone, you may see a green messages box on the home page. Touch it or click OK, depending on the phone.

Click on the messages icon.

You should see a list of your old texts organized by recipient if you've texted people before. If you haven't, it will take you to a blank page.

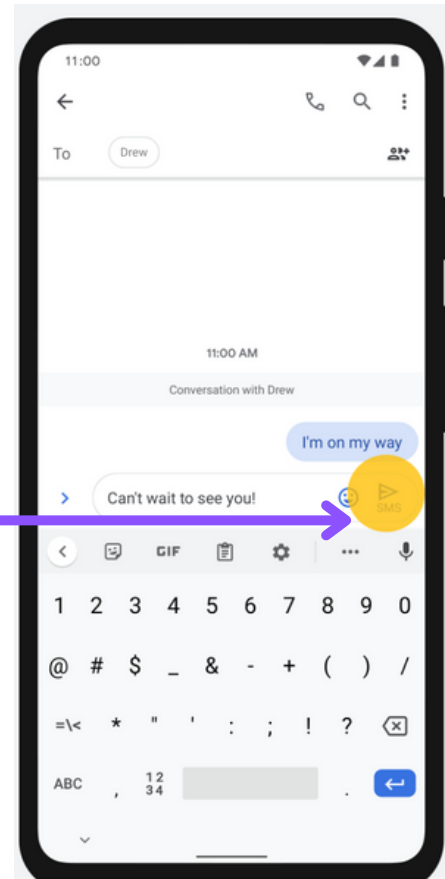
- To continue texting a person you've texted before, simply click on their name or phone number first.
- If you've never texted the person, you will need to have their phone number handy in order to text them. You will be texting directly to their cell phone (or landline).



Type in the phone number of the person you want to message.

You will type this in the message's "To:" field at the top of the message box. Make sure to include the area code.

- You could also select the number from the contact list in your phone's address book. Just type their name in the field, and it might autofill the number in for you. If you've texted the person before, when you start typing in the number, it might also show up automatically for you.
- To send a text to more than one person with a smart phone, simply click on the plus sign icon. Or you can just add more contacts in the To: field by adding more phone numbers or names (if they are in your contact list).
